### Enter the 2009 Earth Day Nature & Wildlife Photo Contest

The Grosse Ile Nature & Land Conservancy invites students to celebrate Earth Day 2009 by participating in a local Nature & Wildlife Photo Contest! Photos will be exhibited during the Grosse Ile Earth Day Celebration at Centennial Farm on Sunday April 26<sup>th</sup> from 1 - 4 pm. Judges will select the Best In Show entry. A People's Choice award will be chosen by ballot during the show. Awards include prestige, publication and gifts.

**Who?** Any high school and middle school student photographer is eligible to participate. Contestants shall only submit their own photos.

**What?** We are looking for photos that celebrate Earth Day and inspire us to appreciate and steward our environment: the air, water, land, resources, wildlife, and ecosystems. Entry categories are:

**Nature** – Photos of plants, flowers, trees, waterscapes, etc.

**Animals** - Photos whose main focus is on animals (wild animals; no pets).

**Landscape** - Photos with scenery as main focus (if present, buildings and people are only incidental to subject).

Photos may be any size from 4x6" to 11x14" in color or black and white, digital or traditional.

**When?** All original entries must be received by Noon on Saturday April 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Where?** Grosse Ile Earth Day Celebration at Centennial Farm - Sunday April 26<sup>th</sup> from 1 - 4 pm. Best In Show and People's Choice awards will be announced following judging and voting (1 -3pm).

**Why?** Express yourself! Show your talent and appreciation of Mother Earth!
